

# Tayammum (Dry Ablution)

It involves wiping of the face and hands with clean soil in a specific way.

# The Reasons for which Tayammum Becomes Permissible

- ❖ Unavailability of Water
- ❖ If a person is afflicted by a disease or surgery because of which water becomes harmful.
- ❖ If the water available is too cold to the extent that it causes harm and there is nothing to heat it with.
- ❖ If a person needs the available water to drink when he is on a journey or in a place where he/she does not find other water.

# Conditions of Tayammum

- ❖ Being a Muslim
- ❖ Being sane
- ❖ Intention
- ❖ The earth used for tayammum must be clean
- ❖ The act obliging ablution or ghusl has occurred.
- ❖ There must be no water, or it is available but the one cannot use it because of illness or fear of harm.

# How to perform Tayammum

❖ Tasmiyah.

❖ Place the hands on the surface of the earth while parting the fingers.  
Then wipe over the face and hands with the palm of the hands.

# Nullification of Tayammum

- ❖ The existence or availability of water.
- ❖ Tayammum is nullified by any thing that nullifies ablution and ghusl because it is an alternative to them.
